The Town of Stafford, Connecticut is seeking sealed bids for furnishing all labor, tools, materials and equipment required for the Replacement of Williamson Road Bridge over Crystal Lake Brook (Bridge No. 134009). Bids will be received by the Director of Public Works, 1 Main Street, Stafford Connecticut 06076 until 10:30 A.M., local time, on Thursday, March 12, 2020. The bids will be publicly opened and read at the Town Hall, 1 Main Street, Stafford, CT 06076 (First Selectman's Office) at 11:00 A.M.

**CONTRACTOR SHALL BE PRE-QUALIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR GROUP No. 8 – MINOR BIDGE CONSTRUCTION**

Plans and Specifications for the above project may be examined and/or obtained for a \$75 fee at the Public Works Office starting February 13, 2020 after 12:00 P.M. EDT. It shall be each Bidder's responsibility to make inquiry (by calling Public Works office) as to the Addenda issued.

All Proposals must be on the form furnished by the Town of Stafford and must be requested for the above-named project.

Each Bidder must deposit with his/her bid a certified check, or a bid bond, for not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid as provided in the Information for Bidders.

The attention of the Bidders is called to the requirement for minimum wage rates to be paid under this Contract.

No Bidder may withdraw their bid within one hundred-twenty (120) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
