JOB DESCRIPTION:

Responsible for the installation, maintenance and repair of computer equipment and peripherals. As a member of the IT Department, the Computer Technician provides technical assistance in investigating and resolving hardware, software, and in installing, maintaining, and updating technology throughout Stafford Public Schools. Other duties include maintenance, installation and reparations of LCD projectors; cabling; maintaining the ticketing system; documenting resolutions for future reference; maintain district-wide technology inventory (computers, printers, peripherals, etc.); and providing training and assistance to end users in the use of computers and other technologies. The position requires driving between school buildings, working in a school environment, and transporting and setting up materials and equipment.
